A cooler and wonderfully pure nose offers up elegant aromas of white and yellow orchard fruit, acacia blossom and a hint of mineral reduction. There is once again a really lovely texture to the delicious and equally succulent medium-bodied flavors that exude a discreet bead of minerality on the linear finish that I suspect will flesh out quickly with a few years of bottle age.

All but invisible wood easily allows the layered aromas of petrol, white peach, apricot and tangerine peel to be appreciated. There is excellent detail and verve to the wonderfully intense mineral-driven medium weight flavors that brim with palate coating dry extract while delivering strikingly good depth and length on the clean, dry, saline and linear finish. This should be first-rate with a few years of age.

All but invisible wood frames notes of apple, white flowers, petrol and a hint of spice. There is both good energy and delineation to the rich, succulent and seductively textured middle weight flavors that culminate in a focused and lingering finish where the only nit is a hint of warmth. Note that this should drink well young.


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
